Mesa Amphitheatre Gets New Technology

With a unique mix of fiber optics, wireless technology, and an on-site Ticketmaster server, the City of Mesa has successfully implemented wireless ticket scanners at the Mesa Amphitheatre. This new process allows staff to track guest attendance quicker and more accurately and reduces the potential for counterfeit tickets, while streamlining patron entry.

The scanners were recently put to the test during one of the busiest weekends ever at the amphitheatre when the bands Killswitch Engage and Flogging Molly performed in front of two sold out crowds.

“The application performed well and allowed speedy entry for the concert guests,” Sherry Woodley, Management Support Administrator said.

The new system brings the Amphitheatre, which now has a seating capacity of 4,950, in line with other local and national concert venues. Wireless scanners are widely used in theatres, arenas, performing arts centers, and other public assembly facilities.

The Mesa Amphitheatre has extended its box office hours. The box office is now open from 9am to 4 pm, Monday through Friday.
